Recreation Activities

Summer Kickoff Camp (Completed 1st-6th grade)

Schedules will be emailed to participants prior to the start of the program. This program will be held Monday thru Thursday with Friday available as a make-up day if a class is cancelled due to rain. Participants should bring their own backpack and water bottle, and wear shoes that can get wet, sunscreen and bug spray to each class.

Critter Camp (Completed 1st-6th grade)

Join us for a week of investigating the creepy crawly cuddly critters around us. Each day we will focus on different groups of animals exploring their habitats and adaptations. We will investigate a pond, river, forest, and prairie to see what we can find and learn. Location will change daily and participants should be ready to walk or explore in the water. This program will be held Monday thru Thursday with Friday available as a make-up day if a class is cancelled due to rain. Participants should bring their own backpack and water bottle, and wear shoes that can get wet, sunscreen and bug spray to each class.

Water Ventures Camp (Completed 1st-6th grade)

Water fun will be the theme of this program as we explore Decorah's various natural water systems. Participants should be ready to walk in water and maybe get a little muddy. Classes will meet at a different location each day. This program will be held Monday thru Thursday with Friday available as a make-up day if a class is cancelled due to rain. Participants should bring their own backpack and water bottle, and wear shoes that can get wet, sunscreen and bug spray to each class.

Survivor Camp (Completed 1st-6th grade)

Each day of survival camp will test and grow your survival skills just like the TV show, Survivor. The week will include: team building, obstacle courses, scavenger hunts, shelter building, foraging for food in the forest, and fire making. Classes will meet at a different location each day.
