June 6-10: Architecture Detective Camp (Completed 3rd-6th grade)

Cost: \$50

REGISTRATON DEADLINE: Friday, May 27

This program taught by Elizabeth Lorentzen will explore seven types of historic architecture viewed through walking tours, miniature house models, historic photographs, and other visual aids. A student-generated architecture detective handbook will be compiled for each student to take home at the end of the week. Stories about the original builders, families who lived in the houses, and other historic information about the homes, and national and local events occurring during the time houses were built will be related. This program will meet at the Winneshiek County Heritage Center (302 S. Mill St), and proceed from there within a five-block area of the historic district, returning to the Heritage Center at the end of each session. Participants should bring a water bottle and wear sneakers to each class. This program is co-sponsored by the Winneshiek County Historical Society.
